Wth Thomas Clark of a
Tring in the County of Bedford Shopkeeper To make this my
last will and Testament in manner following (that
is to say first having already made a will and to the
use of my will) I give and devise unto my Dear wife &
Ann All that messuages or Tenements with the
Appurtenances thereto Belonging now in my own R^{ty}

Occupation situate at Tring aforesaid for and during her natural
life and after her Death I give and devise the same premises unto
my Elder Son Samuel his heirs and assigns forever Subject as
hereafter is mentioned Also I give and devise unto my said
Son all that messuages or Tenements with the Hereditaments
and Appurtenances thereto belonging now in the Occupation
of Daniel Barton situate at Tring aforesaid to hold unto
him his heirs and assigns forever Chargeable nevertheless
together with the said Messuages or Tenements in my own
Occupation with the Payment of the Sum of ffifty pounds
of lawful money of Great Britain which I give to my
Daughter Sarah to be paid her by my said Son his heirs
or assigns at her age of twenty one years Also I give
and devise unto my Son Thomas All those two Messuages
Cottages or Tenements with the Hereditaments and
Appurtenances thereto belonging situate at Wilston in
the said Parishes of Tring adjoining together now in the
Tenure of Thomas Eggleston and Stratford
to hold unto my said Son Thomas his heirs and assigns
forever Subject to the proviso hereafter mentioned &
also I give and devise ^{unto} my Son William All those four
Cottages or Tenements situate at Wilston aforesaid out
of which was devised to me by the last Will of my late

Thomas Clark of Tring in the County of Hertford do make this my last will and testament in manner following (that is to say first having already made a surrender to the use of my will). I give and devise unto my dear wife Ann all that messuage or tenement with the appurtenances thereto belonging now in my own occupation situate at Tring aforesaid for and during her natural life and after her death I give and devise the same promise unto my eldest son Samuel his heirs and assigns forever subject as now after is mentioned also. I give and devise unto my said son all that messuage or tenement with the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging now in the occupation of Daniel Barton situate at Tring aforesaid to hold unto him his heirs and assigns forever chargeable nevertheless together with the said messuage or tenement in my own occupation with the payment of the sum of fifty pounds of lawful money of proof Britain which I give to my daughter Sarah to be paid her by my said son his heirs or assigns at her age of twenty one years. Also I give and devise unto my son Thomas all those two messuages cottages or tenements with the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging situate at Wilston in the said parish of Tring adjoining together now in the tenancy of Thomas Eggleton and [blank] Stratford to hold unto my said son Thomas his heirs and assigns forever subject to the proviso hereafter mentioned. Also I give and devise unto my son William all those four cottages or tenements situate at Wilston aforesaid and of which was devised to and by the Last Will of my late...
